NORTHERN TEXAS PGA INTERNSHIP OPPORTUNITY

The PGA of America is the largest working sports organization in the world with over 28,000 members and apprentices and over 400 staff members throughout the country. As “experts in the game and business of golf,” the purpose of the PGA is to promote the enjoyment of and involvement in the game of golf, and to contribute to its growth by serving millions of people throughout its 41 sections nationwide.

The Northern Texas Section of the PGA of America is headquartered in Dallas, and serves 500 golf facilities and 750 professional members across northern Texas. In addition to managing the day-to-day affairs of the Northern Texas PGA, the Section operates the Northern Texas PGA Junior Golf Foundation. - Ability to work and communicate effectively in a team based environment

- Ability to adapt positively and professionally in a variety of situations
- General knowledge of Microsoft Excel
- Basic knowledge of the game of golf preferred
- College degree (or working towards a degree) required
- Willingness and ability (automobile access) to travel within the Dallas/Fort Worth metroplex required
- Interest in a career in golf or sports administration is preferred

Job Responsibilities:

- On-site tournament responsibilities such as registration, starting, rules officiating, scoring, and awards presentations
- Effectively communicate with parents, juniors and host professional staff
- Reconciliation of financial and result summaries
- Manage equipment inventory and maintenance
- Provide in-office support of the Foundation tournament program
