- Applications must be returned to the Northern Texas PGA by **Friday, March 5, 2010 (receipt date, not postmark date)**. Faxed applications will not be accepted.

- Applicants **MUST** be a 2009 and/or 2010 member (or past members currently in college who were a member of the Foundation their Junior or Senior year of high school) of the NTPGA Junior Golf Foundation. The involvement or achievement in the Foundation tournament program is not a part of the selection criteria.
- Applicants must have completed (or plan to complete) high school prior to August 1, 2010 and enroll (or plan to enroll) in an accredited college or university.
- Along with each application, the applicant must submit the following information.
- A copy of his/her most recent transcript
- A copy of his/her ACT/SAT test scores
- A personal statement
- Finalists will be asked to take part in a formal interview process with the scholarship committee on a specific date.
- Renewal of these awards is dependent upon academic performance.

NTPGA FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FUND SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

A. Purpose

The purpose of the NTPGA Financial Assistance Fund Scholarship Program is to encourage and promote the attainment of higher education goals for Foundation members who have demonstrated a high level of academic achievement during high school or college.

B. Scholarships

The NTPGA Scholarship Program is designed to award one-year and four-year scholarships. The 2010 Scholarship awards are:

Foundation One-Year Awards (\$2,000)

- * Randy Smith Award
- * Nicholas Stafford Award

Foundation Four-Year Awards (\$8,000)**

- * Dallas District Golf Association Award
- ** Renewed annually for four consecutive years.
- Total award amount is listed above.

C. Selection of Winners

Scholarship recipients will be selected on the following competitive basis by using a combination of criteria, depending on class level:

1. Academic Performance—includes high school / college grades, GPA and/or ACT/SAT test scores.
2. Financial Need
3. Extracurricular Activities
4. Personal Statement

Extracurricular activities and a personal statement will help the Committee further evaluate the candidate's interests and abilities. Contributions to the community may be demonstrated by involvement in local clubs and organizations/associations. Extracurricular activities should be documented by type and years involved.

D. Announcement of Winners

Successful applicants will be mailed an announcement on **Tuesday, April 27, 2010**.
