Children's Medical Center Health & Safety Tip of the Week

Sunscreen

With the summer months approaching, kids will be out and about under the blazing Texas sun.

But with so many sun protection options, how do you know what's best for your kids? The key is finding products with an **SPF** (sun protection factor) of 15 or higher, say dermatology experts at Children's Medical Center. SPF protection gives you more time in the sun without getting burned. For instance, if you would normally burn in 10 minutes, and you get an SPF of 15, that gives you 150 minutes before you would start to burn. (10 minutes X 15 SPF = 150 minutes) Also, look for a broad-spectrum **sunscreen**, which protects against UVA and UVB rays (UVA causes aging, leathery skin; UVB causes burning).
