Overuse Injuries

Overuse injuries tend to occur when tissue such as muscle, tendon, bone or cartilage is damaged by repetitive motion



activities. Without adequate time for recovery, the tissue cannot adapt to the demands placed on it and further damage is likely.

The damage caused by repetitive stress leads to tissue inflammation that causes pain. Overuse injuries, also considered chronic sports injuries, can have symptoms that include:

- Pain when performing the activity or sport.
- Intermittent swelling.
- Decreasing performance.
- Dull pain even at rest.

If the symptoms persist, take your child to see his or her pediatrician or a pediatric sports medicine physician. In each consecutive season, repetitive maneuvers by certain
